

Rhinology 360º in One Week Fellowship

One Week VIP Training Program

Program Description

The One Week Fellowship is an intensive program designed for otolaryngologists seeking advanced expertise in Rhinology. During one immersive week, participants will have access to a unique experience, including:

- **Clinical and surgical immersion:**

Observation of pre- and post-operative consultations, focusing on planning clinical and surgical treatments in Rhinology.

- **Side-by-side surgeries with experts:**

Fellows will have the opportunity to closely follow the professors during surgical procedures.

- **High-level theoretical classes:**

Practical and objective approaches to the main techniques and advancements in Rhinology, delivered by renowned specialists.

- **Clinical case discussions:**

In-depth analysis of real cases, with opportunities for participants to bring their own cases for discussion.

- **Guidance on technology and surgical instruments (OPME):**

Professors will teach participants how to select and justify the necessary materials for each surgery.

- **Dissection practice:**

Conducted on fresh cadavers, with detailed demonstrations by the professors and guided step-by-step dissection by the fellows on the following procedures:

- Adenoidectomy with Shaver
- Nasal turbinate surgery
- Sphenopalatine artery ligation
- Uncinectomy and maxillary sinus surgery
- Frontal sinus surgery (Draf 2A)
- Sphenoethmoidectomy

- Nasoseptal flap creation
- Sellar region approaches
- Dacryocystorhinostomy (DCR)
- Medial maxillectomy and access to the pterygopalatine fossa
- Advanced frontal surgery (Draf 3)
- Orbital decompression, superior orbital fissure, and cavernous sinus

** Each participant has the autonomy to focus on the procedures of greatest interest.

*** Each participant will have one side of the specimen for dissection.

All dissections will be performed with advanced technology, including shavers and drills, supported by Medtronic.

• **Discussion group and mentorship:**

After the fellowship, participants will be granted three months of free access to the Rhinology 360 Discussion Group, exclusive to alumni of the fellowship or the “Endonasal Endoscopic Approaches” course. This group meets twice a month to discuss clinical cases presented by the professors on predetermined topics. Participants can also present cases and ask questions.

- State-of-the-art laboratory for endoscopic procedures on paranasal sinuses and the skull base.
- Hands-on experience with real cases and personalized training.
